## **Academic Progression**

Students are responsible for the successful completion of all academic requirements for the completion of their program. Those who are unsuccessful in meeting program requirements are subject to changes in program length and graduation date.

Students can retake courses in which they were either successful or unsuccessful. Those who earned three (3) unsuccessful attempts (Grade of D, F, W) of the same course, are subject to dismissal from the program. After a combination of five (5) unsuccessful attempts (Grade of D, F, W) in all courses, students are subject to dismissal from the program. Students dismissed for exceeding maximum course retakes can opt to appeal the dismissal status. Additional appeal information is found in the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy.
