Add/Drop Policy

A Pierce Mortuary College offers students the opportunity to add and/or drop a course(s) up until ten (10) days from the start date of the quarter. Students can add/drop for only courses within the same quarter

Students who add/drop a course(s), tuition will be billed or refunded in accordance with the tuition and refund policy

Note: Dropping a course(s) may impact your financial aid

Note: Should a distant learner exercise the "add" a course policy, some courses do not have the availability of an eBook, therefore the hardback book will be sent and the student will be delayed in receiving the book

Add/Drop Policy



Student Examples

Example 1

Student A is taking 20 quarter credit hours in their first quarter of the Associate of Applied Science – On-Campus. In their first week of courses, Student A wants to drop their History Course (5 credits) and their English Course (5 credits). Student A doesn't wish to add any courses to their schedule

What happens with the tuition costs?

At the start of the quarter the student is billed based on the tuition policy. The student is taking more than 12 quarter credit hours; therefore the tuition cost is \$3,900.00. With the courses being dropped, the student is now taking 10 quarter credit hours. Because the drops were within the add/drop period, the student's tuition will be adjusted to \$2,600.00 (10 credits * \$260.00 per credit) from \$3,900.00

Example 2

Student B is taking 19 quarter credits in their fourth quarter of the Associate of Applied Science – On-Campus. In their first week of courses, Student B drops three courses worth 15 quarter credits and adds one course worth 4 quarter credits.

What happens with the tuition costs?

With the change of courses, the student is now taking 8 quarter credit hours at \$260.00 per quarter credit from the full-time (12 or more quarter credits) tuition rate of \$3,900.00

Example 3

Student C is taking 16 quarter credit hours at the beginning of their quarter and wishes to drop one course worth 5 credits and add one course worth 3 credits within the add/drop period of their Funeral Director Program

What happens with the tuition costs?

With the change of courses, the student is still taking more than 12 quarter credit hours. The initial tuition charge of \$3,900.00 will not change
